A Narrative-Driven System

When a character attempts something risky or challenging, the player rolls 2d6 and adds a relevant stat (like Passion, Creativity, or Focus). A total of 10 or better is a full success; 7-9 is a success with a cost, twist, or complication; and 6 or less is a failure, which often grants the player "Experience" to grow their character. This "fail forward" mechanic keeps the game dynamic. You are not just swinging a sword; you are trying to waterbend a wave to douse a fire, and on a mixed success, you might succeed but lose your footing, creating a new problem for your team to solve.

Playbooks: Your Character's Archetype

Instead of rigid classes like "Fighter" or "Wizard," character creation in the **Avatar Legends The RPG Core Book** uses "Playbooks." These are archetypal roles inspired directly by characters from the shows. Examples include **The Bold** (like Sokka), **The Guardian** (like Iroh), **The Hammer** (like Toph), **The Icon** (like Korra), and **The Idealist** (like Aang). Each Playbook comes with unique moves, abilities, and, most importantly, a specific character growth arc. This is where the game truly shines. It is not about leveling up to get a higher damage bonus; it is about resolving internal conflicts and changing your relationship with the world.

The Balance Track: A Unique Character Growth Mechanic

This perfectly mirrors the character arcs of Zuko, Aang, and Korra, who all had to lose their balance to find a new, stronger one. It is a stroke of narrative genius that makes every session feel like an episode of the show.

Setting and Eras: Which Avatar World Will You Explore?

The **Avatar Legends The RPG Core Book** covers a vast timeline. While the core rules are setting-agnostic, the book dedicates substantial space to describing different eras. The primary focus is on the "Avatar Era" (the 100 Year War from *The Last Airbender*) and the "Republic Era" (the rise of Republic City and the Equalist conflict from *The Legend of Korra*). However, the book provides enough detail and adventure hooks to set a game during the time of Kyoshi, Roku, or any point in the history of the Four Nations which has not been explored in detail.
