This local customization ensures that you see only the channels available to you, along with accurate local program times for Las Vegas.

## How to Access the Cox TV Guide

There are several ways to reach the Cox TV guide for Las Vegas Nevada:

You can also switch between grid view and list view. Grid view shows multiple channels and times simultaneously, while list view displays one channel’s full schedule in a vertical list. Press the “View” or “Display” button to toggle.

Tips for Getting the Most Out of Your Cox TV Guide

Mark Your Favorites

Once you set your favorites, the guide will let you view only those channels. To do this, press “Guide,” then “Menu” or “Options,” choose “Favorites,” and add channels. Update this list seasonally as shows change.

The guide shows programming up to seven days in advance. On your remote, press the right arrow to advance to future days. This is perfect for scheduling weekend movie marathons or setting up series recordings.

Filter by Category

Many Cox remotes allow you to filter the guide by genre — “Sports,” “Movies,” “Kids,” “News,” etc. Press the “Filter” or “Category” button to narrow down the grid. This is a huge time-saver when you want to know what’s playing on sports channels in Las Vegas without scrolling through every channel.

Voice Search and Commands

If you have the Contour voice remote, press the microphone button and say, “Show me action movies tonight on HBO” or “Find Golden Knights game.” The guide responds instantly, voiced search even understands “Cox TV Guide Las Vegas Nevada” as a phrase.

Set Series Recordings

Instead of recording each episode individually, choose “Series Record” when you mark a show. The DVR will automatically capture new episodes (and reruns, if you prefer) until you cancel. This works well for
